**KC2026 Transport Mobility Plan RFP #2024-001**

**Questions and Answers**

1. Was the Pre-Bid Meeting recorded and available by chance?

*A: The pre-bid meeting was not recorded.*

2. What is the anticipated budget for the scope outlined in the RFP?

*A: This is a qualifications-based selection and the fee will be negotiated after selection.*

3. If members of the selection committee are currently employed by a firm (or a subsidiary of a firm) that submits a proposal in response to this RFQP, will those selection committee members recuse themselves from the process or will those firms be disqualified due to a conflict of interest?

*A: KC2026 is sensitive to conflict of interest concerns. Individuals who are employed by a firm (or its subsidiaries/affiliates) going through the selection process will not be permitted to participate as members of the selection committee and will not be permitted to participate in the selection process individuals; the selection team composition will be based on responses received.*

4. Will KC2026 preclude consultant teams from proposing if they assisted in the development of the RFP or are acting as an Owners Representative/Owners Agent?

*A: KC2026 is sensitive to conflict of interest concerns and individuals/consultants who assisted in the development of the RFP will not be allowed to submit or assist in the submission of a proposal in response to this RFP.*

5. Is it possible to receive a list of attendees from the June 10, 2024 pre-bid meeting?

*A: Yes, the list will be posted on the website.*

6. Is it possible to receive a summary of Questions and Answers from the June 10, 2024 pre-bid meeting?

*A: Yes, the questions asked at the pre-bid are included in this list of questions.*

7. Are vendor teams that are comprised of several firms able to submit their proposal as a Joint-Venture (JV) team, or with the intention of forming a JV team if selected by KC2026?

*A: Yes, any teaming arrangement is encouraged to submit a proposal.*

8. What is the expected seating capacity of Arrowhead Stadium during the FIFA 2026 WC tournament?

*A: See RFP, page 3.*

9. Is there a requirement for the Host City to provide free transit service to ticket holders on game days?  
*A: The current Host City requirement for free transit is only for FIFA accredited individuals, not all ticket holders.*
10. If applicable, is it possible to be added to a distribution list to be notified of any addenda, RFIs, answers to questions, and notifications regarding this RFP?  
*A: Yes, please send your name, company, and email address to [kansascityfwc26@sportkc.org](mailto:kansascityfwc26@sportkc.org).*
11. For the proposal document, is it permissible for the standard letter size pages (8.5" x 11") to be oriented in Landscape format?  
*A: Yes.*
12. Can a copy of the FIFA application be made available for our review so we can see what commitments were made during the bid stage? Also, please make available "...obligations under the Host City agreement."  
*A: The Host City agreement is not publicly available at this time.*
13. For the proposal evaluation, can the weighting / scoring for the proposal sections (e.g. Qualifications and Experience, Project Approach, Past Performance, References, etc.) be provided?  
*A: The evaluation criteria is included in the RFP.*
14. Can the names of the members of the Selection Committee be provided?  
*A: Selection committee members may be published at a future date.*
15. Can a list be provided of the anticipated background data and sources that would be made available to the selected team following award, or if there are any commitments by key agencies that will be working with the selected team to provide relevant planning and operational level data.  
*A: The currently available background data is provided in the RFP.*
16. In reference to section 5.d. References - Is it acceptable to submit more than three references?  
*A: Yes, three references is a minimum.*
17. Will you provide the expected contract or contract terms?  
*A: The contract will be provided to the selected team.*

18. In reference to section 3. Background of Project... - "This includes fan transport to / from fan fest locations and event venues." Referring to Figure 4, are all of the airports, base camp sites, the fan fest area, potential park and ride areas, and Arrowhead Stadium considered the "event venues"?

*A: The FIFA Fan Fest and Arrowhead Stadium are the FIFA venues for fan events. Transport planning scenarios could include the airports, Team Base Camp Training Sites, Venue Specific Training Sites, potential park and ride areas and other locations/venues identified.*

19. How will the transportation team work with existing city transportation groups?

*A: Currently there is a team in place comprised of multiple city and state transportation groups to assist KC2026 with Host City requirements and they will continue to meet moving forward. As you respond to the RFP, consulting groups should outline their proposed engagement opportunities.*

20. Is the RFP for preparation/ planning or operation?

*A: Both. The response to the RFP should be all inclusive to a plan that includes outlining preparation, operation, and compliance efforts.*

21. Will a fee for work to be released?

*A: Proposals will be assessed based on qualification and then compensation negotiations will follow.*

22. Will KC2026 be releasing FIFA documents or minutes from partner (transportation group) meetings to provide a better understanding of the project and what has transpired thus far?

*A: FIFA documents are not available to the public.*
